





•Problem: channeling new technologies to help in addressing urban issues


•Questions: How to engage stakeholders? How to provide them with tools for understanding and addressing urban issues?

Stakeholder A: Peter, 20 years old, university student, going to Nashmarkt to hang out and meet friends, he lives outside the center of Vienna so he comes by public transport.

He loves the area's ambience but he is not aware of the river's existence. Stakeholder B: Omar, 52 years old, shop-owner. He is not familiar with Internet.

He has been working in Nashmarkt for the past 23 years. He is interested in maximising his margins and the area's attractivity.

Stakeholder C: Ella, 35 years old, is living in the area with her children. She goes to Nashmarkt everyday to shop fresh ingredients.

She is concerned about the area's security and environmental issues. Stakeholder D: Mr. Schicker, 50 years old, is urban planner working for Vienna's municipality.

He is coordinating the project for the Nashmarkt's development. He is adopting a sustainable development approach and worried about the preservation of the place's historical memory. Stakeholder E: Lisa, 30 years old, is an environmental activist.

She is leading an association for the preservation of Vienna's biodiversity. They have been collecting material on the covered river.

































Pedestrian Flow in Urban Environment

- Motivation
 - People are attracted by different elements(e.g. sightseeing spots, restaurants) in a region, like magnet to particles.
- Simulate the "magnetic field" or "attractive field" of different spots to evaluate the pedestrian traffic.
- Application examples
 - Accessibility evaluation
 - Estimation of attraction of certain spots, e.g. shop, restaurant



Exploring Future

- City exploring simulator, visualization of the city plan
- Exploring the future in different views, e.g. pedestrian, giant, fish or bird
- Sharing suggestions and comments























Water level Temperature Flow speed Water quality


